- People who have installation experience without accreditation
- Police Clearance
- South African
- Proof of physical address in specific installation area
- Access to reliable transport (own transport preferable)
- Able to read and write
- Computer literacy will be an added advantage
- Mobile camera Cellphone
- Must be able to provide installation daily progress report together with all necessary signed documents
- Able to work under pressure to meet critical targets.
- Must be able to educate viewers on the use of STB
- Must be able to adhere and work within all health and safety guidelines
- To strive for excellence in all service provided
- Previous working reference on domestic satellite and/or terrestrial TV antenna installations will be an added advantage.
